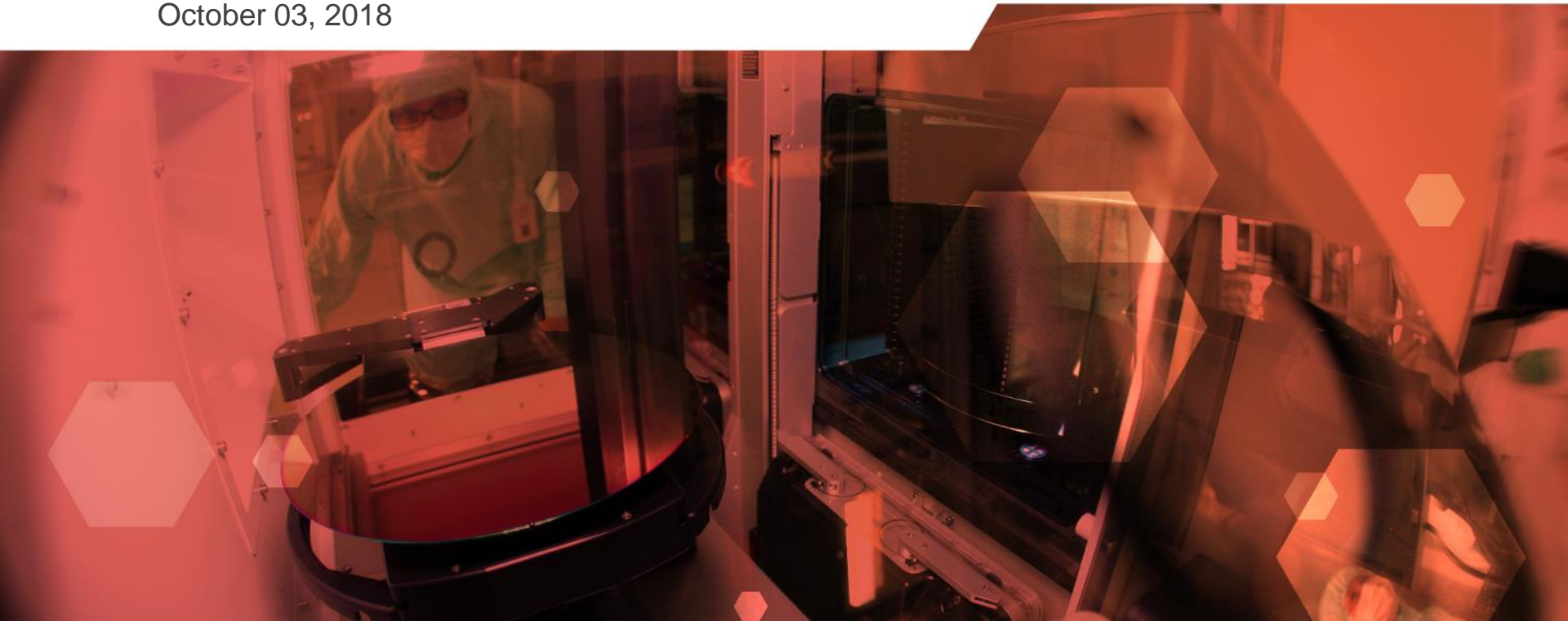

SEMI Taiwan Staff Report [4/4]

- Sections 16.4.1 and 16.4.4 of the recently revised of the Regulations contain requirements for the use of trademarks in published Documents. Existing Documents have been found that contain trademarks for items such as materials, software protocols, and equipment. All TC Chapters should review their Documents at the time a revision or reapproval ballot is planned to determine if a trademark is used and, if so, whether its use is justified, properly represented, and that a footnote references the trademark owner. Failure to do so could jeopardize ballot approval.
